at the beginning of July which contains their wonderful artwork. It is such a special thing to keep and look through as they grow older. Please speak to Natalie if you have any questions.




Barnardo's Toddle Waddle

These are fantastically fun activities which help to promote and develop speaking and listening skills in our youngest children. These schemes follow on to 'Children Chatter' which is a program used with preschool children. This has again been very successful in helping our older children to move forward in their speaking and listening. Along with our daily phonics learning, BLAST (Boosting Language Auditory Skills and Talking) and graduate sessions, our nursery is thrilled with the amazing progress of our children and we have had some very positive feedback and lovely comments from other professionals including the SALT (speech and language team).
