Please let us know if you are unable to attend the parents' evening and we will look at an alternative day and time.


### Beautiful Butterflies


## Learning Journey Books:

### Baby Babble and Toddler Talk

Well done!

Our youngest pips have been taking part in Baby Babble and Toddler talk sessions at nursery. These are fantastically fun activities which help to promote and develop speaking and listening skills in our youngest children. They have been very enthusiastic and we have already noticed some incredible developments in our children's speech. These schemes follow on to 'Children Chatter' which is a program used with preschool children. This has again been very successful in helping our older children to move forward in their speaking and listening. Our oldest pips, the Graduates, have started segmenting and blending their sounds this week in preparation for learning to read. They are doing fantastically well! Along with our daily phonics learning, BLAST (Boosting Language Auditory Skills and Talking) and graduate sessions, our nursery is thrilled with the amazing progress of our children and we have had some very positive feedback and lovely comments from other professionals including the SALT (speech and language team).
